Hot keys for Linux

You can view all keyboard shortcuts in your Accessibility settings.

Sign in to the Zoom desktop client. Click your profile picture then Settings. Click Accessibility.

The accessibility settings and keyboard shortcuts will appear.

Available shortcuts

General

Ctrl+Tab: Switch from one tab to the next

Meeting

- Alt: Toggle the Always show meeting controls option in General settings
- Alt+V: Start/stop video
- Alt+A: Mute/unmute my audio
- Alt+M: Mute/unmute audio for everyone except the host (available only to the host)
- Alt+S: Start/stop screen sharing
- Alt+T: Pause/resume screen sharing
- Alt+R: Start/stop local recording
- Alt+C: Start/stop cloud recording
- Alt+P: Pause/resume recording
- Alt+N: Switch camera
- Esc: Enter/exit full screen mode

Alt+U: Show/hide participants panel Alt+I: Open the invite window Alt+Y: Raise/lower hand Alt+Shift+R: Begin remote control Alt+Shift+G: Revoke remote control permission

Chat

Alt+Shift+T: Screenshot Ctrl+W: Close current chat session

Phone

Ctrl+Shift+A: Accept inbound call. Ctrl+Shift+E: End current call. Ctrl+Shift+D: Decline inbound call. Ctrl+Shift+M: Mute/unmute mic. Ctrl+Shift+H: Hold/unhold call.

iOS

If you are using an iPad with a keyboard, the following shortcuts are available in a Zoom meeting:

Command + Shift + A: Mute/unmute my audio

Command + Shift + V: Start/stop my video

Command + Shift + H: Display/hide chat

Command + Shift + M: Minimize meeting

Command + U: Display/hide manage participants

Command + W: Close the front window, such as the participants or meeting settings window
