

Hot keys for Linux

You can view all keyboard shortcuts in your Accessibility settings.

Sign in to the Zoom desktop client.

Click your profile picture then Settings.

Click Accessibility.

The accessibility settings and keyboard shortcuts will appear.

Available shortcuts

General

Ctrl+Tab: Switch from one tab to the next

Meeting

Alt: Toggle the Always show meeting controls option in General settings

Alt+V: Start/stop video

Alt+A: Mute/unmute my audio

Alt+M: Mute/unmute audio for everyone except the host (available only to the host)

Alt+S: Start/stop screen sharing

Alt+T: Pause/resume screen sharing

Alt+R: Start/stop local recording

Alt+C: Start/stop cloud recording

Alt+P: Pause/resume recording

Alt+N: Switch camera

Esc: Enter/exit full screen mode

Alt+U: Show/hide participants panel

Alt+I: Open the invite window

Alt+Y: Raise/lower hand

Alt+Shift+R: Begin remote control

Alt+Shift+G: Revoke remote control permission

Chat

Alt+Shift+T: Screenshot

Ctrl+W: Close current chat session

Phone

Ctrl+Shift+A: Accept inbound call.

Ctrl+Shift+E: End current call.

Ctrl+Shift+D: Decline inbound call.

Ctrl+Shift+M: Mute/unmute mic.

Ctrl+Shift+H: Hold/unhold call.

iOS

If you are using an iPad with a keyboard, the following shortcuts are available in a Zoom meeting:

Command + Shift + A: Mute/unmute my audio

Command + Shift + V: Start/stop my video

Command + Shift + H: Display/hide chat

Command + Shift + M: Minimize meeting

Command + U: Display/hide manage participants

Command + W: Close the front window, such as the participants or meeting settings window
