MEET THE EDITORS OF LAG PUBLICATIONS

Many bygdelag have publications which continue to keep members informed. Telelag has two publications, a newsletter and an historical magazine. A few groups are seeking new editors and a few have just assumed their positions.

Some groups exchange publications on an informal basis—and it may or may not be every issue. Many have three or four issues a year while *Budstikken* publishes information for Valdres Samband members in May and December with many more pages each time. An exchange may depend on the rate of postage paid as well.

If you wish to consider an exchange with another lag, send them a sample copy of your newsletter and ask if they wish to exchange once or twice a year, for example. Usually lags that do this have some common genealogic or geographic connection. It may also be a way to share ideas another editor may consider using.

Most of the editors listed regularly send copies to the Fellesraad president. There may be others who belong here but are not listed. In any case, the editors are free to email or otherwise contact each other to determine if reciprocity is desirable or if another group might also be interested in some news item that has come to you.

Listings appear, alphabetically, by lag with an e-mail or a phone number. Those with an asterisk (*) are seeking one or more permanent editors.
