#### DAY 1 SUNDAY, MAY 12

Mpls/St. Paul — Oslo: Depart on your transatlantic flight. To request alternate dates or for estimated airfare supplements from other US cities, please note on application.

#### DAY 2 MONDAY, MAY 13

Oslo: Arrive at Gardermoen Airport Oslo. Transfer to hotel. Balance of day free to adjust to time change or visit the main Deichman Library independently. Welcome dinner and overnight at the Grand Hotel.

#### TUESDAY, MAY 14 DAY 3 [B]

Oslo: Morning sightseeing tour (8:30-12:30pm) features the Norwegian Folk Museum and Frogner Park, featuring the works of Norway's sculptor, Gustav Vigeland (1869-1943). The tour also includes the Vigeland Museum located in the studio and home of the famous sculptor. Balance of day free for independent explorations. Dinner on own. (Option: Riksarkivet is open until 5:30 on Tuesday.)

#### **WEDNESDAY. MAY 15**

[B.D] Oslo-Asgardstrand: Drive to Kongsberg. Visit the Norwegian Mining Museum with a local guide. Pending availability tour the Kongsberg Church, one of two monumental churches from the 1700's and Norway's largest baroque church. Drive by statsarkiv enroute to Borre. Learn about the Viking Age at the Midgard Historical Center, located next to Northern Europe's largest assembly of monumental grave mounds from the Germanic Iron Age and the Viking Age. The burial mounds in Borre constitute one of Norway's most important national heritage sites, as it was a place of power and influence in Europe during the Viking Age. Continue to charming Asgardstrand. Dinner and overnight at the Grand Hotel.

#### **THURSDAY, MAY 16** DAY 5

**Åsgårdstrand-Arendal**: Morning tour of the first home owned by Norway's internationally-known painter, Edvard Munch. Some of his most famous paintings are depicting the local area, including the "Girls on the Bridge". Continue along the coast passing Tønsberg, Norway's oldest city and on to Sandefjord, the whaling capital of Norway. Visit the Sandefjord Museum, dedicated to the whaling industry. It is the only specialized museum on the subject of whales and whaling in Europe. Proceed to Porsgrunn. Tour the Porcelain Museum (Porselensmuseet). The gift store offers designer items such as porcelain, jewelry and textiles. Drive to the lively port city of Arendal, once recognized as a major shipping center with numerous wealthy shipowners. A great many of Americans in New York City and the surrounding areas (Brooklyn, Port Richmond (Staten Island) and at industrial centers in northern New Jersey) who claim Norwegian ancestry, can trace their roots to Arendal. Dinner and overnight at the Clarion Hotel Tyholmen.

#### DAY 7 SATURDAY, MAY 18

Arendal: Sightseeing in local area with Jorunn Raddum and Per Dag Hole. Dinner. Overnight at hotel.

#### SUNDAY, MAY 19

Arendal - Kristiansand: Proceed to the maritime town of Grimstad, where we find scores of yachts in the harbor. At the beginning of the 19th century, the town had no fewer than 40 shipyards and carried on a lucrative import-export trade with France. It was here where Henrik Ibsen worked as an apprentice pharmacist for 6 years. Tour the Ibsen House/ Grimstad By Museum which holds the largest collection of Ibsen memorabilia in Norway. Enroute to Kristiansand lunch on own at the Randesund Gift and Candlemaking Shop. Sightseeing upon arrival in Kristiansand includes a drive-by of statsarkiv. Dinner. Overnight at Thon Hotel Kristiansand.

#### DAY 9 MONDAY, MAY 20

Kristiansand—Stavanger: Travel the North Sea Scenic Highway, the link between Southern and Western Norway. The coast has some of the finest and longest beaches in Norway. At Hå, the road runs only a few feet from the open sea and pebble beach. The play of light and color, land and sea has been an inspiration and motivation to a number of artists who live in this area. Enroute to Stavanger, we pass through Jæren, one of Norway's leading agricultural districts. Sightseeing upon arrival in Stavanger includes a visit to the Norwegian Petroleum Museum. Dinner and overnight at Clarion Hotel Stavanger.

Lunch at the historic Fleischer's Hotel. Proceed to Bergen for overnight at Opus Hotel.

For reservations or final payment made within 21 days prior to departure, there is a \$50 per reservation handling/express fee. Checks, Money Orders, VISA, MasterCard and American Express are accepted as forms of payment. Please review and verify your booking invoice and contact your travel agent or Brekke Tours immediately if your invoice appears to be incorrect or incomplete. Brekke Tours cannot accept responsibility if we are not notified of inaccuracies within 5 days of sending out the invoice. In case of billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice with correct pricing.

#### TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

It is the responsibility of each passenger to obtain proper travel documents, such as passport and visa. Each passenger must be in possession of a passport with a validity of at least six (6) months beyond the conclusion of their trip. A visa is not required for Scandinavia or Western Europe for stays of less than 3 months. A visa is required for passengers traveling to Russia.

It is imperative that your airline ticket matches your name as it reads on your passport. Any changes to your air booking, which include spelling, are subject to a minimum change fee of \$250. With full payment, tour documents are normally sent 14-21 days prior to departure and should arrive within 6 business days. If you request documents earlier, and if it is possible to accommodate you, there is a \$50 per reservation handling/ express fee.

#### CANCELL ATIONS

The following per person cancellation fee applies: More than 75 days prior to departure: \$400; 74-45 days: \$2000; 44-7 days: \$2500; less than 7 days: nonrefundable.
