

Mary Gjermo 1948 -2023

Mary Margaret Gjermo, age 75, of Cambridge, Wisconsin, passed away on Nov. 21, 2023. She had been a member of Romerikslaget since 2006. Mary was born in Madison, WI and graduated from Cambridge High School in 1966, attended St. Olaf College for two years, and graduated from Mundelein College in 1971 with a B.A. in Psychology. She received a degree in Library Science and later an M.S. in Family Studies. She was the Director of the Cambridge, WI Community Library and was a Supervisor at the La Crosse, WI Public Library. Failing health caused her to end her library career in 1990.

Mary had a second part-time career as a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist. She was active in her community, including serving on the board of the Koshkonong Prairie Historical Society.
